Rules and Procedures

The criteria for nomination are as follows:

- Native (or adopted) sons and daughters of Midvale who have made significant contributions to Midvale and/or those whose accomplishments and achievements have brought fame and recognition to Midvale as a community.
- Members of the Arts Council or elected officials of Midvale, while in office, are ineligible.
- Application forms must be completed for each nominee and received at City Hall by the annual deadline. Applications received after the deadline will be retained and considered the following year.
- Nominees can be individuals, couples, or groups.
- Nominees will remain on the nomination list for five years from the time of application. If at the end of the five-year period, a nominee has not been selected for induction, he/she will be removed from the nomination list unless nominated again.
- One nominee will be selected for induction each year. (Arts Council can make an exception to this rule in any given year.)
- Nominees should be living or recently deceased. (Arts Council can make an exception to this rule in any given year.)
